FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ABOUT CAMP CARE AND THE FUNDRAISER

- 1. What is Camp CARE?** Camp CARE is a non-profit 501(C)(3) organization, which services both Presbyterian Hemby Children's Hospital and Carolinas Medical Center Levine Children's Hospital, relies entirely on donations and is committed to providing a summer camp and other year round activities for children ages 3-17 and their families, who have or have had cancer.
- 2. Why is Camp CARE hosting a 5K Run/Walk FUNdraising Event?**
Answer: All services provided by Camp CARE are at no cost to the campers or their families. Camp CARE is supported entirely by donations and money raised through fundraisers like this one.
- 3. What will the funds raised for this event support?**
Answer: 100% of the monies raised will go to fund Camp CARE's operating budget. It cost over \$500 per child for the week of camp with all of the money coming from donations of supporters like you. There is never a cost to the campers or their families.
- 4. What if I don't want to participate in the 5K or walk but want to donate to the fundraiser?**
Answer: Sponsor a team by sending your check, made payable to Camp CARE, to us at the address below or use a credit card to make a donation to Camp CARE at www.campcare.org.

If you wish we will wear a ribbon with your loved one's name on it during the race in their honor or memory. After the race, we will mail the ribbon to you as a memento of your participation in our fund raiser.
- 5. What if I have a business that would like to donate to the fundraiser?**

- 6. Where will the event be held?**
Answer: McAlpine Creek Park, 8711 Monroe Road, Charlotte, NC
- 7. What is the date and time of the event?**
Answer: Saturday, September 10, 2011. Check-in time will be at 7:30 until 8:30 AM and the race will begin promptly at 9:00 a.m. You will pick up your race day bag and t-shirts at check-in. Walkers and runners start at 9 AM. Runners will be at the front of the lineup.
- 8. Who can participate in the event?**
Answer: Open to all who want to attend or help.

9. What is the cost of participating in the event?

Answer: Pre-event Children Grades K thru 12 = \$15.00

Pre-event Adults = \$22.00

Day of the Event = Adults \$30.00

Day of the Event = K thru 12 = \$20.00

10. How do I register for the event?

Answer: You can register on-line at www.campcare.org

11. Can I bring small children and strollers?

Answer: Yes. Strollers are allowed; however, strollers must start at the rear for safety reasons.

12. Do I have to run?

Answer: No, you may run, jog or walk. Also for safety reasons, please no bikes.

13. How should I dress for the event?

Answer: Dress for the weather, comfortable exercise type clothing & shoes, and layers.

14. Will we be timed?

Answer: Yes, Timing will be by **Run For Your Life**

15. Can we bring our dog?

Answer: Yes, if on a leash.

16. Will there be first aid available?

Answer: Yes.

17. What if it is cold or raining?

Answer: Bundle up! The event will go on, rain or shine.

18. Will there be restrooms available?

Answer: Yes.

19. Will there be any events after the race?

Answer: There will be a short awards ceremony recognizing the fastest runners overall and in each age group; there will be a short awards ceremony recognizing the team and individuals raising the most money for Camp CARE and the team and individual that wears the most In Honor Of or In Memory Of ribbons.

There will also be a cookout, music, drumming, face painting and family fun!!
