#### DIRECTIONS TO CAMP CARE

- From Charlotte, take I-85 South
- Go past Gastonia, and as you approach King's Mountain, take Highway 74 West Follow this through Shelby.
- Look for Exit 167/ Highway 9.
- Follow Highway 9 until it dead ends at Lake Lure.
- Take a right on Highway 74/64A.
- Look for a golf course on the right, followed by a fire station on the left.
- Immediately after the fire station, turn left on Charlotte Drive.
- Take first left onto Lurecrest Drive.
- Follow up the hill to Camp Lurecrest/ Camp CARE!

#### Camp CARE Staff Checklist

Stuff to survive the week!

- Twin sheets and a blanket (or sleeping bag if you want to rough it)
- Pillow
- Bath and beach towels, washcloths
- Flashlight (with extra batteries)
- Alarm clock/watch
- Clipboard or notebook with a few pens
- Toiletries (soap, shampoo, deodorant...please, toothbrush, toothpaste, sunscreen, bug spray, hair dryers, etc.)
- Prescription medications (plan to leave your meds in the Med Shack)
- Extra fans for your cabin. (If you forget we have a bunch there already)
- Any cabin decorations!
- Snacks! Feel free to bring a stash of snacks/drinks for additional fueling. We ask that you label any food you bring and keep it in the designated staff area, and not consume in front of campers.
- Clothes (8 days and 7 nights worth) Please keep in mind that you're now working with children; keep your clothing modest and appropriate. You will be asked to change if needed.
- Underwear, clean socks
- Outfit for the dance (fancy optional) and anything you would like for breakfast themes.
- One pair of jeans if you'd like, but shorts work best during the day...duh its summer.
- Lightweight jacket or sweatshirt
- Raincoat or poncho
- Two pairs of sneakers (one that can get muddy and wet). You may also want to include a pair of water shoes.
- One pair of clothes that can get ruined
- You may wear sport sandals with backstrap.
- Flip flops (for shower and pool areas only)
- Swimsuits please choose modest swimsuits!!!!
- Laundry bag washer and dryers are for emergencies only
- Please only use your cell phones for cameras in front of campers. Save phone calls and social media scrolling for your free time away from campers!
